MINUTES: Site Council Meeting - September 18th, 2019

- **Welcome/Call to Order 5:29pm**
 - Introductions
- **New Business**
 - Officers – Election/Appointment

 - **Review Minutes** – motion, second, and all in favor - passed
 - **Patton Jr. High – State Assessment Data** Tested each year in Spring as a summative assessment
Teachers looked at data to see what they can do to move students to the next level.
The individual scores will be given to parents at PTC along with STAR scores. No decision had been made by the district to give out the scores last May, so they were not given out then.
 - ELA –
 - Well out performed the state average
 - Reviewed Performance Level by Grade
 - Claims and Targets were reviewed by grade level
 - 7th grade meets all, 8th grade had 3 areas that needed improvement
 - Math –
 - Again, well out performed the state average
 - We have had the most improvement in math over the last 3 years. Over 10% growth.
 - Still focusing on Level 1s and 2s.
 - During LEAD there is intervention to provide extra instruction.
 - The higher level students are being challenged in the classroom.
 - Go Math Tiers have been implemented with improved success.
 - All Freshmen will take the pre-ACT in October to measure success for Freshmen
 - Claims and Targets were reviewed
 - 8th grade has an exceeds Target because of Mrs. Faught's focus on Geometry standards.
 - She also pulls kids that she knows is moving so that she can help close the gap in standards from other states.
 - Problem Solving in 7th grade was an area that needs improvement.
 - Science –
 - Again, out performed the state average
 - Met all Claims and Targets for 8th grade

 - We are in year 3 of Accreditation out of 5 year cycle
 - 7 Rose Capacities
 - 4 Steps where the BOE approves and acknowledges
 - **Patton Goals:** Surveys are taken by students; Part 1 last week, part 2 this week and again in the Spring
 - **Relevance** - *Over the course of the first accreditation cycle and through professional development opportunities, Patton educators will grow their pedagogical skills to increase academic achievement for all students through a minimum of 90% student engagement as demonstrated through a 2% increase from baseline data on the STAR assessment at the end of 2018-19.*
 - **Relationships** - *Over the course of the first accreditation cycle, Patton staff will actively participate in job embedded professional learning opportunities (e.g. peer mentoring and peer observations) to improve staff/student relationships, empower students, and create a culture of positive student involvement through student ownership of their learning and behavior; resulting in increased positive student behavior referrals and academic success.*
 - Implemented with Action Teams
 - **Five Outcomes** – two are focused on at Patton
 - **Social Emotional**
 - **Individual Plans of Study and Xello**
 - Career Interest Surveys and Counselor programs with Xello
- **Kansas Interim Assessment Window** – in preparation for summative report in the Spring
 - **October 7th – October 18th – Reading and Math**
 - Students will get results – Met, Partially Met, or Not Met at all for whatever standard the question went over.
- **Parent Teacher Conference**
 - Open Forum with each teacher having a table to talk with parents
 - First Come, first served
 - Book fair will be in Tiger Pit
